



CAMPING POLICIES

All campgrounds are ticketed areas. All sales are final; no refunds, exchanges or returns. Camping passes are per vehicle and non-transferrable. Any passes seen damaged are void and will not be accepted to enter the Bands In The Backyard Campgrounds.

CAMPING LOAD IN SCHEDULE

Thursday July 8 : 10am-8pm

RV's may be loaded in but no overnight camping will be permitted.

Friday July 9 :

10am-2am (all campers will be required to be parked by 8pm)

Saturday June 10:

10am-2am (all campers will be required to be parked by 8pm)

Sunday July 11:

All campers must be off grounds by 2pm

Friday 7/9 and Saturday 7/10 :

Quiet time will begin at 2am each night in all campgrounds.

CAMPSITES MAY NOT MOVE ONCE IN PLACE

General Camping Policies

- Campers must wear camp access pass at all times. Everyone entering the campgrounds must have a full-event wristband on. Single day ticket holders DO NOT have access to the campgrounds.
- All vehicles MUST have their camping pass on their windshield/dash for proper display. Vehicles without their pass properly displayed are at risk of tow at owner's expense.
- Within each campsite, you can park one steering mechanism and one sleeping unit; a drive-able RV counts as both. Any additional vehicles will need to purchase a parking pass to park in an alternate parking lot. Motorcycles are vehicles. Should you choose to bring a motorcycle to Bands in the Backyard, it must have the appropriate tag. Unlicensed vehicles, are not permitted on site.
- All roads in the campgrounds are fire lanes and must be kept clear at all times. If you exceed the boundaries of your campsite into these fire lanes, we will ask you to purchase an additional campsite and we may need to relocate you. Any vehicles found to be blocking the fire lane will be towed at owner's expense.
- Your camper or RV must fit entirely in your campsite; if it does not fit, you must purchase multiple sites.
- A 2:00 AM curfew is strictly enforced in all campgrounds.
- No vending is allowed in the campground areas. Violators will be removed from the premises. No exceptions.
- Secure your campsite – Bands In The Backyard is not responsible for lost, damaged, or stolen items.
- Bands in the Backyard reserves the right to dismantle and/or remove any structure, pool, dance floor, or any other item that it determines to be a safety concern for patrons or staff.
- Upholstered household furniture is not allowed in the campgrounds. If you bring any of this furniture to the festival site, you will be fined \$100 by campground staff.

Camping Options

Bands In The Backyard offers various campgrounds to camp during the festival which can hold an RV, car, or tent. All persons who purchase a campsite must have an admission ticket and may start setting up camp Thursday before the festival. There is no limit to how many people can stay on your campsite as long as each person has a camp access pass and admission ticket. Each campsite come with 4 access passes. Additional passes may be purchased. **Campsites are available in the following sizes 20x30, 20x40, 20x60**

Safety & Health Regulations

All RVs and vehicles in the campgrounds must have at least 10 feet of separation from each other including slide outs. Group camps (i.e. campers with a group of two or more campsites) **MUST** fit within the designated and assigned space purchased and can not be in any road way (including all tow vehicles).

If you choose to line the outside of your sites with RVs and create a common space in the center, you must allow for emergency access to the center area in the form of two 10- foot openings at opposite ends of your camp. This will be **strictly** enforced by campground security and local EMS.

All generators must be properly vented away from sleeping units, including tents and RV's. Generators must be separated from tents by a minimum of 20 feet and protected from contact by fencing or other approved means. If you have an onboard generator, consider buying a generator exhaust kit to route the CO2 out of your own and surrounding campsites. Please ensure that your RV is equipped with a working carbon-monoxide detector. The festival will have safety staff monitoring the placement of generators to ensure that it is safely exhausting harmful fumes away from enclosed sleeping areas. If not, then safety staff will require you to either move, shut down or properly vent your exhaust. All camping is primitive. Port-o-potties, and garbage disposal are provided.

Security/Emergencies

Security is provided by Pueblo County Sheriff's Department and Bands In The Backyard. Citations will be issued for violations. Drinking age of 21+ will be enforced. In the event of severe weather, a warning will be issued by patrol cars. Please follow instructions given. If you need to be notified for an emergency, your family must contact the Pueblo County Sheriff's Department.

Fill Up Your Pool/RV

There will be water trucks assigned to a certain area of the campground. Once you have the pool ready for water, you can flag them down to fill. The cost to fill a pool is approximately \$125 per 1,000 gallons.

Curfew

A 2:00 AM curfew will be enforced in all campgrounds. Please respect your fellow campers. Generators must be shut off at 2:00 AM. Security officers have the authority to ask any person or groups of people who are abusing the noise curfew to leave the grounds without a refund. All state and local laws will be enforced by law enforcement personnel.

Campfires

No campfires or open flames will be allowed. If you are bringing a grill, all grills must be at least 12 inches above the ground or any vegetation. No solid fuel grills (i.e. charcoal, wood, etc.) are allowed. Propane grills only, charcoal grills are not permitted as they are a fire hazard.

Generators

All generators should be vented above the height of your camping unit using an exhaust kit especially if there are people camping in tents near your generator. Please make sure your RV is equipped with a CO detector and if your neighbor is running a generator make sure they are properly venting it.

Large RVs

Our campsites are all 20 feet wide and either 30 or 40 feet deep depending on where you have purchased your site. Your RV must fit in your designated space. If you have an RV longer than 30 or 40 feet you **MUST** purchase two sites back-to-back to pull through. All roads in the campgrounds are considered fire lanes and must be kept clear at all times.

ALLOWED ITEMS IN CAMPGROUNDS

- Festival wristbands and passes Tent and rain fly
- Tarp
- Flag/Balloon (to identify your campsite) Table
- Chairs
- Beverages (no glass containers) Food
- Ice
- Coolers (outside food & beverages not allowed into the concert field)
- Generators (must be vented above your camper and shut off by 2:00 AM)
- Propane grills (at least 12 inches above the ground or any vegetation)
- Sunscreen Bug spray Toilet paper Towels
- Small luggage lock (for your tent) Pets
- Lawn games Pool

PROHIBITED ITEMS IN CAMPGROUNDS

Prohibited items will be confiscated and not returned

- Illegal substances of any kind Firearms or weapons of any kind Large hammers or sledge hammers Glass containers or bottles of any kind
- Open flames (no charcoal or wood fires)
- External speakers (small bluetooth speakers are OK) Furniture, refrigerators or carpeting
- No: ATVs, Golf Carts, Mopeds, Bicycles, Skateboards, Scooters, Hoverboards or any other similar devices, with the exception of those permitted for handicap transportation, are allowed. Unauthorized vehicles may be impounded and Bands in the Backyard accepts no responsibility for such vehicles.

Trash

The Bands in the Backyard site is beautiful - please help us to keep it that way. Please ensure that you bring trash bags with you to the festival, pick up your trash and keep your campsite clean. Please place bags in large dumpsters that are found in your camping area.

Pets

We love our pets, but we strongly recommend that you leave them at home. The crowds can cause distress for many animals. If you do bring a pet, you are responsible for your pet. Pets must be **LEASHED** and kept at your campsite at all times. You are responsible for cleaning up after your pet. Please keep your pet safe and secured on your campsite. Aggressive pets are not allowed, and will be removed from the campground. No pets will be allowed into the festival at any time (except approved service dogs).

Alcohol

If you are of legal drinking age and plan to drink alcoholic beverages, please carry your age identification (i.e. driver's license) with you at all times (even after being wrist banded), as you may be stopped and asked for identification. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Under Age Drinking is NOT permitted in the campgrounds or on the event grounds. Anyone found participating in, or contributing to underage drinking may be evicted from the grounds immediately without refund.

Consumption of alcoholic beverages, by those of legal drinking age, is allowed in your own camping area only. Alcohol consumption is prohibited on any roadways.

Vending

Unauthorized vending or soliciting on site is strictly prohibited. This includes, but is not limited to: food, beverage, merchandise, and entertainment. Unauthorized selling of items will result in seizure of merchandise, eviction and possible prosecution. Unauthorized wrapped or sponsored vehicles may be turned away at the front gate, at the sole discretion of Bands in the Backyard.

Bands in the Backyard reserves the right to modify or add any rules at any time.
